
PRIOR TO INSTALLATION



a. Setting the Dipswitches

Before installing the Adaptiv Mini interface into the vehicle, please set the dipswitches on the interface box (i.) according to the specifications as outlined below:




DIP If the vehicle has OEM reverse camera: Yes - 'ON' No - 'OFF'


Please note: All connections from the Adaptiv Mini interface are made to the rear of the OEM head unit, except for the climate control harness which must be connected to the rear of the OEM climate control panel.

a. Climate Control Harness

Please see Page 3 for connector images and connect the climate control harness according to the below instructions:

- 1. Remove Conn. D from the back of the OEM climate control panel
- 2. Plug Conn. D into Conn. A of the Adaptiv climate control harness
- 3. Plug Conn. B from the Adaptiv climate control harness into the space previously occupied by Conn. D
- 4. Connect Conn. C to the 2 pin connector on the Main Wiring Harness (purple/pink wire)






Rear of OEM Climate Control Panel

MMI Type 1 - 'Return' button




MMI Type 2 - 'Back' button

b. HDMI Access

1. Select Aux In from the Media source list.

Note: An AMI to 3.5mm cable must be connected to the AMI socket in order to activate the Aux input. 2. Hold **'Return'** or **'Back'** for 2 seconds to switch between the OEM screen and the Adaptiv Mini HDMI screen.



Note: If a video in motion warning message is displayed, double press 'Return' or 'Back' to continue

c. Front & Rear Camera Access

Note: Front and rear camera view can be accessed from either OEM or HDMI screens

- 1. Select reverse gear to activate OEM or aftermarket reverse camera
- 2. Deselecting reverse gear will activate aftermarket front camera (if DIP 2 is 'On')
- 3. To cancel front camera, accelerate over 10mph or double press 'Return' or 'Back'.





To access the aftermarket front camera manually (if DIP 2 is 'On'), double press 'Return' or 'Back

Note: To view the version number of the product and to access firmware information, hold '**Return'** or '**Back'** for 8 seconds
