

# AEB102BT Manual

## Introduction

Thank you for purchasing the AEB102BT bluetooth ear buds. Please ensure that you have read the product manual and instructions in full, prior to installation and use. Failure to do so may result in product failure/damage or incorrect operation and therefore impact the product performance.

## Charging the battery

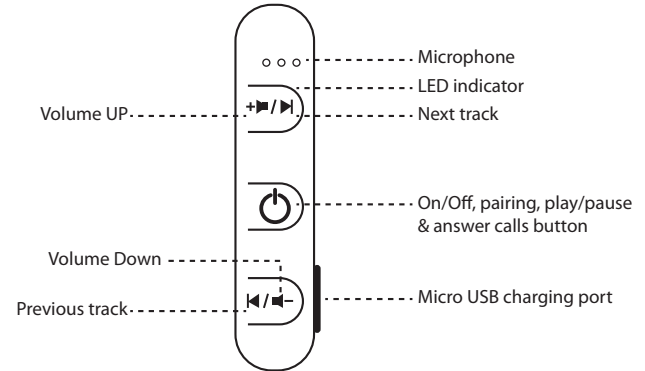
Charge the AEB102BT with the supplied USB charging cable for 2 hours before use.

## Pairing

Make sure the charging cable is disconnected from the headphones. Otherwise it will not pair. Press and hold down the round On/Off button on the controller until a blue LED indicator light will activate and start flashing. A voice prompt says "Power on, the bluetooth device is ready to pair", followed by the LED flashing between blue and red. The headphones are now ready to pair with your bluetooth device.

Go into your settings on your bluetooth device and search for the pairing name AERPRO AEB102BT to connect (pair). Once it has successfully paired the voice prompt will say "The bluetooth device is connected successfully", then the blue/red LED indicator light will stop flashing and remain blue. Press and hold down the round On/Off button to disconnect. The voice prompt will say "Power off".

**Note:** Bluetooth will automatically pair with you paired phone when you turn your headphones on.



## Playing music

When playing music quick press the On/Off button to play and pause your music.

## Skip track

Quick press on the (+) button to forward track.  
Quick press on the (-) button for previous track.

## Volume

Long press on the (+) button to increase volume.  
Long press on the (-) button to decrease volume.

## Answering calls

Short press On/Off button to answer incoming calls. Short press again to end call.
